

# Encompass Health Timeline

**Feb. 22, 1984:** Amcare was incorporated in Birmingham, Alabama.

**1985:** Amcare changes its name to HealthSouth Rehabilitation Corporation.

**1985:** HealthSouth acquires HealthSouth Rehabilitation Hospital of Florence, its first inpatient rehabilitation hospital.

**1997:** HealthSouth builds a new corporate headquarters in Birmingham on HealthSouth Parkway (now known as Grandview Drive).

**2001:** HealthSouth introduces the AutoAmbulator, a sophisticated treadmill featuring a body weight supported ambulation designed to help patients safely relearn natural walking patterns.

**2006:** HealthSouth announced a strategic plan to reposition itself as a pure-play, post-acute care provider.

**2007:** HealthSouth divested its diagnostic and surgery divisions as part of its strategic plans.

**Aug. 29, 2011:** HealthSouth adds a sixth company region during a realignment strategy.

**Dec. 2012:** HealthSouth opens 100th inpatient rehabilitation hospital in Ocala, Florida.

**Dec. 31, 2014:** HealthSouth purchases Encompass Home Health and Hospice based in Dallas, Texas.

**May 2, 2015:** HealthSouth launches therapy research grant program.

**Oct. 1, 2015:** HealthSouth adds 11 hospitals to its network through the purchase of Reliant Hospital Partners.

**Nov. 11, 2015:** HealthSouth purchases CareSouth and adds 45 new home health locations.

**Aug. 31, 2017:** HealthSouth announces Post-Acute Innovation Center with Cerner.

**Jan. 1, 2018:** HealthSouth officially converts to its new name Encompass Health Corporation and the stock ticker changes to “EHC.”

**Feb. 6, 2018:** Encompass Health Corporation rings the bell at the New York Stock Exchange announcing the company’s new stock ticker symbol.

**April 2018:** Birmingham employees move into their new Home Office in the Liberty Park neighborhood of Birmingham.
